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
Beaux Frères Vineyard & Winery – Since the first vintage in 1991, Beaux Frères’ philosophy has remained the same; to produce a world-class Pinot Noir from small, well-balanced yields and ripe, healthy fruit. Their minimal intervention winemaking approach is non-manipulative and uncompromising and guarantees wines that are a natural, authentic expression of the vineyard. The partnership includes Managing Partner Michael Etzel, his brother-in-law (Beaux Frères) Robert Parker Jr. and business partner Robert Roy. The wines are consistently ranked as some of the New World’s finest Pinots.



Masseto – Masseto is the celebrated 100 % Merlot IGT that is viewed by many as one of the best expressions of Merlot in the world. An incredible success story that can be traced back to a combination of the magical terroir of the 7 hectare Masseto vineyard along with the vision of esteemed winemaker – Axel Heinz. The vines are cultivated in alluvial, sandy-clayey soils that are rich in minerals. The wine is one of great structure and longevity and is produced in extremely limited quantities. A Masseto experience is a rare opportunity indeed!



Château La Nerthe – One of Châteauneuf-du-Pape’s oldest estates, Château La Nerthe is recognized as a benchmark producer for the region. While officially established in 1560, some archives suggest that their history dates back to the dawn of the region’s wine culture in the 12th century. Located near Avignon, the 225 acres of vineyards are located in a single plot around the Château and have been certified organic since 1998. The dense, deeply coloured, impeccably balanced wines are, without question, some of Châteauneuf-du-Pape’s finest.



Foxtrot Vineyards – Foxtrot is a small family-owned and operated winery located on the Naramata bench in the Okanagan Valley, British Columbia. The winery specializes in ultra-premium Pinot Noir and Chardonnay and has received praise from top sommeliers and international wine critics alike. The Allander family purchased the vineyard in 2002 with a philosophy that focuses on a small, hands-on, attention to detail approach that has elevated Foxtrot to one of the true cult wines of B.C.



Chappellet Vineyard – In 1967, acting on the advice of legendary winemaker André Tchelistcheff, the Chappellet family settled atop of Pritchard Hill on the rocky eastern slopes of the Napa Valley. Over the five decades since, Chappellet has earned a reputation as one of Napa Valley’s preeminent family-owned wineries, and one of the pioneers of high-elevation vineyard planting. During this same time, Pritchard Hill has emerged as one of California’s most revered winegrowing sites and a source for some of the world’s finest mountain-grown Cabernet Sauvignon.



Far Niente – Established in 1885, Far Niente produces Napa Valley estate bottled Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon – wines that are known for their consistent house style and ability to evolve with extended age. Joining Far Niente on this special evening will be sister wineries: EnRoute with the extraordinary Pinot Noir from the Russian River Valley, Nickel & Nickel and their renowned 100 % varietal single vineyard bottlings from the Napa Valley and last, but not least, Dolce – the pursuit of perfection in the art of late harvest winemaking; best described as ‘liquid gold’.
