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TWO HANDS WINES


Château La Nerthe – One of Châteauneuf-du-Pape’s oldest estates, Château La Nerthe is recognized as a benchmark producer for the region. While officially established in 1560, some archives suggest that their history dates back to the dawn of the region’s wine culture in the 12th century. Located near Avignon, the 225 acres of vineyards are located in a single plot around the Château and have been certified organic since 1998. The dense, deeply coloured, impeccably balanced wines are, without question, some of Châteauneuf-du-Pape’s finest.



Château Margaux – Château Margaux is an estate in the Bordeaux region and was founded in the 1400’s. In 1804 it was purchased by the Marquis de la Colonilla who built the spectacular chateau and cellar buildings in use today. It was one of four wines to achieve First Growth status in the Bordeaux Classification of 1855. Since 1977 it has been run by the Mentzelopoulos family and enjoys renewed fame as it has returned to its tradition of beauty and excellence.



Duckhorn Vineyards – Founded by Dan and Margaret Duckhorn in 1976, Duckhorn Vineyards has been crafting classic Napa Valley wines for nearly 40 years. This winemaking tradition has grown to include 7 farmed Estate vineyards, located throughout the various microclimates of Napa. Focused on quality and consistency, these Estate vineyards are an essential element in making wines of distinction. Pioneering and perfecting Merlot as a premium varietal, Duckhorn Vineyards now makes several elegant Merlot and distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon bottlings that showcase its premium vineyard sites.



DuMOL – Originally founded as a family winery in 1996, DuMOL is a winemaker-owned producer of cool climate Russian River Valley Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Syrah, and Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from exceptional vineyards. Working intimately with their many unique sites they strive to present the purest essence of the vineyard and vintage. DuMOL’s estate parcels in the Russian River Valley are among the most densely planted vineyards in North America. Winemaker, viticulturist and partner, Andy Smith, has been at the helm of DuMOL’s continuous evolution since 1999.
