

Robert Foley Vineyards – Bob Foley began his wine making career in the Napa Valley in 1977, working at a number of highly regarded wineries including the famous Pride Mountain Vineyards, where he spent 15 years as founding winemaker. In 1998, Bob bottled his flagship Claret and has since expanded and diversified the production to offer more of the big reds he is famous for. Always seeking to create new, fun, and interesting wines, Bob has also bottled three of his favorites: a Pinot Blanc, a Rhône-style White Wine, and a Syrah that is named after his wife, “Kelly’s Cuvee”.



Château Palmer – An estate, in the Margaux appellation, renowned for the quality of its wines since the beginning of the 18th century, Charles Palmer spent 30 years enlarging and modernizing it; finally instilling it with such a timeless style, it would forever carry his name: Château Palmer. Since 1938, Château Palmer has distinguished itself as one of Bordeaux’s leading Grand Crus. Today, they entrusted the direction of Château Palmer to Thomas Duroux, but continue to ensure the estate grows sustainably, attentive to the world that surrounds it.



Maison Joseph Drouhin – For the last 130 years, Maison Joseph Drouhin has been in the hands of the Drouhin family. Today, Laurent Drouhin and his siblings, part of the fourth generation at the helm, are animated by the same passion that inspired the founder of the company. With close to 90 different appellations, Joseph Drouhin offers a fascinating array of Burgundy terroirs in all their authenticity and subtle variations. It is one of the most important domains in Burgundy, with more than two thirds of the vineyards classified as Premier and Grand Crus.



Carlisle Winery & Vineyard – A small Sonoma County winery specializing in the production of old-vine, vineyard designated Zinfandels and red Rhône varieties. Mike Officer and his wife Kendall have recently added their first whites, two blends from historic, old-vine vineyards plus Sonoma County’s first ever Grüner Veltliner. Their goal is always the same – grow and source outstanding fruit, do as little as possible to it, and bottle outstanding, pleasurable wine at the fairest price possible.
